



The Plymouth LINK may set up focus groups to meet and think about specific issues. These might be:

- To consider how specific health or social care services should be improved, for example to follow up an action plan for the hospital
- To help improve the LINK, for example to develop some new LINK work
- To talk about new health or social care services and get involved in planning a service

The need for a Focus Group will be agreed by the Stewardship Group.
There are two ways you can get involved in a focus group:-

- 1) If you have told us on your registration form that you are interested in a specific service or issue we may contact you about the opportunity to get involved in a focus group on that service or issue;
- 2) Register your interest on any of the opportunities by clicking on the Volunteer Application Form in *Get Involved/ Volunteer*.

Anyone involved in the LINK can be part of a focus group and your out-of-pocket expenses will be paid.
