## Proposed Training Programme For LINK Members

Anyone in Plymouth can get involved in the LINK. We are offering free training to support people to learn new skills to do this. Training can be flexible to suit your situation, so please contact us.

The following Training Programme has been split into three sections, depending on how you would like to get involved in the LINK:

### If you would like to know more about the LINK and how it will work :

- \* **Introductory Workshops** - about the purpose of the LINK and its powers, how you can get involved and the role of the Host Team.
- \* **Equality & Diversity/Cultural Awareness** - to help LINK members understand the need for the LINK to work with all communities and groups in Plymouth, and how it will achieve this.

- \* **Talking to communities** - how the LINK will make sure it reaches the people of Plymouth and how members can get involved and support the LINK.



This course can also support community groups to improve their practice.

### If you would like to represent the LINK:

- \* **The role of the Ambassador** - an introduction to various groups and forums that influence health and social care services and the role of a LINK ambassador on these groups.

- \* **The role of the Visiting Team** information about the Code of Conduct for the Visiting Team and the reason for visits; how they should be carried out, including monitoring and reporting on visits.



- \* **Protection of Vulnerable Adults (POVA)** - gives members insight into working with vulnerable people and how to recognise and respond to abuse of vulnerable people.

- \* **Lone Working** how LINK members can keep themselves safe when they are involved in LINK activities.

### If you are a member of the Stewardship Group:

- \* **How the LINK will work** - more detailed information about LINK regulations, powers, finances, accountability and policies and procedures
- \* **Chairing Meetings** - how to effectively chair meetings, get results and make sure everyone has their say.
- \* **Media Training** - basic information about handling the media, covering the LINK's policy and procedure on dealing with the media
